15 JULY 2022 | In presence event at Politecnico di Torino Room R - Via Paolo Borsellino, 53

The event, organised in presence at the Politecnico di Torino, was a success, with 77 participants in total, including 40 master's students and 29 people from companies and organisations and 8 researchers from PoliTO's Systemic Design research group.

Alongside the speakers from the Politecnico di Torino, who presented the results of the MULTITRACES project to date with their Intellectual Outputs, there were master's students who made interesting contributions, presenting their Systemic Design Projects. In addition, the participation of companies from the regional and national scene strengthened the dissemination of the project results.

INTERDISCIPLINARY EDUCATION FOR THE CIRCULAR ECONOMY

[Original Title: Educazione interdisciplinare per l'economia circolare]

DESCRIPTION

Local and regional contexts are crucial places for the circular economy, and the agro-industrial and forestry sectors offer many opportunities for the development of circular enterprises that enhance a short supply chain involving local actors. However, in these sectors the circular economy also poses important challenges to the world of industry and training: on the one hand, it requires strong industrial innovation to deploy new management and production tools; on the other, it needs to train new professional figures capable of developing and managing circular innovation.

The Second Multiplier Event leaded in Torino proposes a reflection on this topic, presenting how Systemic Design can face these challenges through its approach and capabilities. The intervention of speakers and students who relate closely to this discipline served to convey the added value that the discipline has within interdisciplinary contexts.

PARTICIPANTS

Of the 77 participants, 29 came from outside the MULTITRACES partner (PoliTo).

Looking at the external participants, the composition of the audience was in line with the objectives of the event:

- 52% of companies, mainly SMEs but also large enterprises from the agro-food sector;
- 28% of public organisations, such as regional innovation clusters and agri-food public organisations and schools;
- 17% of research centers and universities, especially public centers such as national zooprophylactic institutes;
- 3% of professionals, working as freelance in the rural economy sectors;
